Purpose: The purpose of this paper is to update the ECRI White Paper entitled Corporate Corruption / Code of Conduct posted in 2010 noting the enterprise risk posed to engineering and construction contractors by bribery and by governmental sanctions for involvement in such activities and to identify available resources to assist companies in enhancing their efforts to address this risk.

Introduction: Reference is made to the ECRI Best Practice entitled Enterprise and Portfolio Risk Applicable to an Engineering & Construction Contractor (ECRI-EP-001). As defined in that BP, enterprise risk includes risks related to compliance with internal ethics and code of conduct rules and external anti-corruption laws.
