Introduction: Most projects are a myriad of managerial and technical interfaces which pose a risk to the project. Management of Interfaces between the Client and the E&C Contractor; between the E&C Contractor and his Subcontractors; those between E&C Contractors in a consortium or in Joint Venture; and terminal points at the Battery Limits are just some of the important interfaces that need to be managed effectively in order to ensure a successful outcome. The other key is to reduce the number of Interfaces wherever possible.

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
